## Beyond Co-Management: PFF Approach



**INCLUSIVE**: involves and relies on community members and others to build a vision for taking care of their land.

**PLACE-BASED**: happens on the land—not in an office — so that people are connected to the places they are making a plan about.

**INDIGENOUS-LED**: Led by Indigenous people, creating roadmaps for how their territories should be managed — rather than Indigenous people reacting to plans developed by others for their territories.

**INFORMED**: Relies on local and Indigenous knowledge about values, threats, and strategies to protect lands and waters. It also draws on other information and expertise as needed.

## What is H<sub>i</sub>do Gogha Sénégots'ıáá

• Hıdó Gogha Sénégots'ı pá (Planning for the Future) provides the Board with a way to involve Dene and Métis "in a direct and meaningful manner" in planning for wildlife and conservation.

• The Board supports Hıdó Gogha Sénégots'iaá to help implement the land claim objectives in the Sahtu.


• The Board believes Hıdó Gogha Sénégots'ia is an important next step for co-management.

# Policy Statement



HĮdó gogha sénégots 12á (Planning for the Future – PFF) is a community-based, rights-compliant, governance framework that reflects and respects local Dene and Métis knowledges, customs, and practices.

HĮdó gogha sénégots 17 à is a viable conservation approach that is community-led and a more effective and more rights-compliant alternative to harvest limits.



# Principles

#### 1. ?asį́į Godí hé Dene Ts'įlį hé (Biocultural Diversity)

Dene expect decisions that affect them to account for rasįį godí hé Dene ts'įlį hé (all living things and Dene ways of being).

#### 2. ?edets'é K'áokerewe (Self-Regulation)

In Dene ?e?a (law) people and wildlife are called upon to respect each other's autonomy as a basis for social cohesion and survival in a harsh environment through ?edets'é k'áots'erewe (self-regulation).

#### 3. Godi Kehtsį (Ethical Space)

Dene and Métis participation in conservation efforts with government depends on godi kehtsį (fair consideration or coming together of diverse perspectives, or ethical space), including science and Indigenous knowledge through relexé reghálats'eda (collaborative) systems of accountability.


## February 9 Terminology Workshop
