- 1. Control forest fires on immigration routes
- 2. -Less caribou biologist interference
 - -Helicopter harvesting caribou while collaring, which may result in females dropping their fetus before birth.
- 3. More predator control, examples are wolves, bears etc.
- More control given to communities to control and regulate their own harvesting, no tags for Fort Good Hope.
- 5. No sponsored hunts on barren land caribou of any kind
- 6. Deline plans of caribou management should apply to Deline District only hunters from Deline should not hunt in other districts unless agreed by affected RRC's.
- 7. Fort Good Hope RRC has already been doing control of caribou hunting for the past three years.
 - 1. No sponsored hunts in Colville Lake area.
 - Sponsoring other hunts such as fishing, moose hunting etc.
 - 3. The Board is also considering banning hunting during migration season.
- 4. Need more funding to do alternative hunting, reopen traditional trails to past harvesting areas.

8. The SRRB should seriously consider Fort Good Hope reccomendations.
