Délįnę Closing Comments

January 23, 2020

- 1) The Délįnę delegation supports Colville Lake Caribou Plan. This was expressed throughout the sessions by Leon Modeste and Alfred Taniton.
- 2) Délįnę seeks to establish an agreement between Colville Lake and Délįnę Gotine Government for the use of Horton Lake. Délįnę owns fee simple title lands around Horton Lake.
- 3) Délįnę wishes to establish a traditional trade system with Colville Lake to increase building relationships with Colville Lake First Nations. We have fish they have caribou. Small amounts of these resources can be traded. This is happening now with many of our harvesters, though family ties.
- 4) We should share and celebrate our successes in these plans, reward our champions of the plan. Together.
- 5) Máhsı to all the leaders, cooks, cleaners, elders, and entertainers and most of all the children and young people, without them entertainment is impossible.
- 6) Délįnę offers to host the next Public Listening Sessions next year on February 22nd to 24th, 2021.
- 7) It is necessary to establish a framework for collaboration before any harvesting takes within our traditional areas.
