Notice to Sahtú leaders, Parties, and neighbours, **April 6, 2020**

The ʔehdzo Got'ıne Gots'é Nákedı (Sahtú Renewable Resources Board – SRRB) regrets to inform the Parties and the public that due to disruptions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, the Board has decided to change the timeline for delivery of the Colville 2020 Public Listening Report to the Minister of Environment and Natural Resources by one month, to **April 30, 2020**.

The Board reminds Parties in the hearing that section 13.8.24(b) of the *Sahtú Dene and Métis Comprehensive Land Claim Agreement* (SDMCLCA) provides that, unless the Minister directs otherwise, the SRRB's Final Report will remain confidential for a period of 60 days, or until **June 29, 2020**.
