DEHLÁ GOT'INE TS'IDUWEH ?ƏDƏ ?E?Á, 2019

1. Harvesters from BAFN or AYKLC, who know how to harvest ?ƏDƏ, or any other wildlife, using Dehlá Got'ine traditional harvest methods, are authorized to harvest ?ƏDƏ in the Dehlá Got'ine area for personal and family food.
2. Harvesters from other communities, who are Treaty status or a beneficiary of the Sahtu Land Claim Agreement, who are planning to harvest ?ƏDƏ or any other wildlife for personal and family food, must receive majority consent and written authorization from the Colville RRC before entering the Dehlá Got'ine area. Harvesters must then be accompanied by a Colville RRC monitor to ensure compliance with the *Dehlá Got'ine Ts'iduweh ?ƏDƏ ?e?á, 2019*.

3. Harvesters who do not have Treaty status or are not a beneficiary of the Sahtu Land Claim Agreement are not permitted to harvest ?ədə in the Dehlá Got'ine area.
4. Harvesters who do not have Treaty status or who are not beneficiaries of the Sahtu Land Claim Agreement who are planning on harvesting wildlife (other than ?ədə) must request authorization from Colville RRC, before entering the Dehlá Got'ine area.

5. Harvest of ʔədə must be for personal or family food.
6. Harvest of ʔədə by hitting with a stick, axe or any other type of club is extremely disrespectful to ʔədə and is strictly forbidden as a major offence.
7. Burning of any harvested ʔədə is extremely disrespectful to ʔədə and is strictly forbidden as a major offence.

8. ʔƏDƏ harvest site must be clean and the whole ʔƏDƏ must be used.
9. Harvested ʔƏDƏ must not be sold for cash or traded for any alcohol or drugs.

Respect the Dehlá Got'ine ʔƏDƏ ʔEʔÁ for the harvest of ʔƏDƏ. Ask your elders and other experienced Dehlá Got'ine harvesters for more harvest laws and specialized knowledge.

ENFORCEMENT BY COLVILLE RRC WILDLIFE MONITORS & ENR OFFICERS

- Colville RRC, BAFN and AKLC will pass the Dehlá Got'ine Tseduwh ʔədə ʔeʔá and ENR and SRRB is working with Colville to help enforce the Dehlá Got'ine ʔədə ʔeʔá.
- Colville RRC monitors and ENR have permission from the Colville RRC to ask any harvesters in the Dehlá Got'ine area if they have authorization from Colville RRC to be harvesting in the Dehlá Got'ine area.
- Be prepared to provide proof of your authorization to either a Colville RRC wildlife monitor or ENR officer.

HOW TO RECEIVE AUTHORIZATION

Majority consent and written authorization, from the Colville RRC, before entering the Dehlá Got'ine area, must be received.

VIOLATIONS OF DEHLÁ GOT'INE TS'IDUWEH ʔƏDƏ ʔEʔÁ, 2019

Colville RRC has a Justice Council to address violations of the Dehlá Got'ine ʔƏDƏ ʔEʔÁ, 2019.

Colville RRC Justice Council has 3 members:

- based on Dehlá Got'ine traditional laws and values;
- work with Colville RRC & ENR monitors; and
- sanctions include bans from harvesting in the Dehlá Got'ine traditional territory, participating in harvest education classes, community services hours, fines and referrals to ENR officers/ NWT courts.
