RE: Opportunities to provide input following the March 1-3 Bluenose East ʔekwé Hearing

The ʔehdzo Got'ı̨nę Gots'é Nákedı (Sahtú Renewable Resources Board) wishes to thank all the Parties and the public for their valuable contributions to the Bluenose East ʔekwé hearing on March 1-3. The Board understands that many people were unable to make it for various reasons, including travels on the winter road and the illness that was affecting many people during that time. The Board has decided to take the following measures to ensure that people have full opportunities to provide input:

1. **Changed timelines:** The timeline for submissions by the Parties and the public is extended to May 6, and the deadline for final submissions by the two proponents (Délı̨nę and NWT Environment and Natural Resources) is extended to May 20. The Board's final decision will be delivered on June 20.
2. **Validation list:** The Board is preparing a list of key messages and questions emerging from the hearing for review and feedback by the Parties, forthcoming soon.
3. **ʔehdzo Got'ı̨nę meetings:** The Board offers to provide funding support for one ʔehdzo Got'ı̨nę meeting per community to discuss the list of key messages and questions, and prepare final submissions. The Board recommends that these meetings take place in April.
