Responses to Information Requests – Round 3 - Délıne 2021 Virtual ʔelets'ehkwę Godı (Public Listening Session): Tıch'ádı hé Gots'edı (Living with Wildlife): Predators and Competitors

On December 9, 2021, the Government of the Northwest Territories Department of Environment and Natural Resources (ENR) received the Round 3 Information Requests (IR) from the ʔehdzo Got'ıne Gots'ę Nákedı (Sahtú Renewable Resources Board - SRRB).

On December 20, 2021, ENR received correspondence from the SRRB with a completeness analysis for Round 1 and 2 IRs. ENR has reviewed the analysis and has no concerns with this assessment. As noted by the SRRB, ENR's responses to Round 1 IRs (1.B.3 and 1.C.3) will be included in our written submission which is due on January 28, 2022.

ENR is in receipt of the Notice of Postponement sent by the SRRB on January 13, 2022, we will wait for the situation to improve and the SRRB to resume the Délıne 2021 Virtual ʔelets'ehkwę Godı (Public Listening Session).
