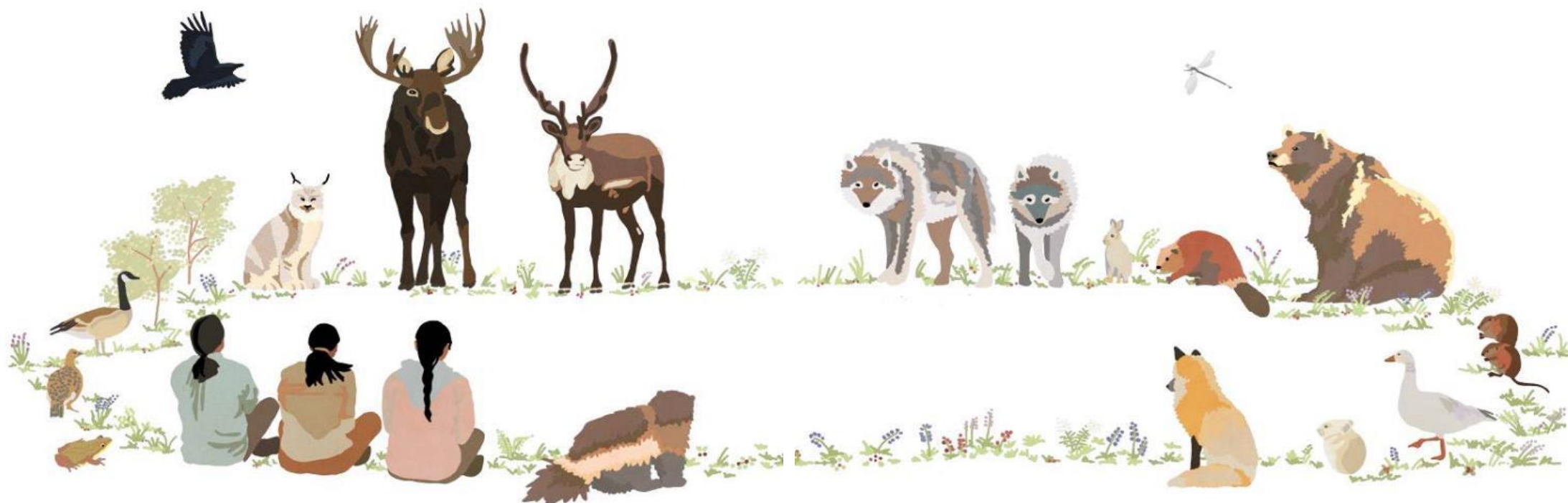

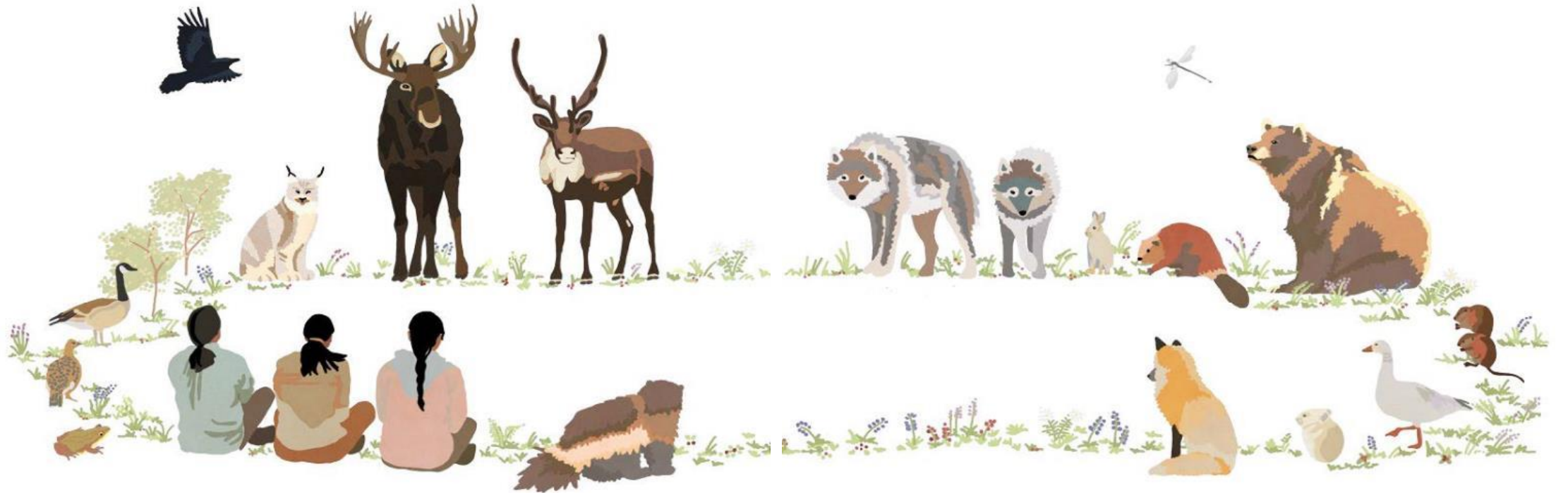

Ask for technology/ terminology pause

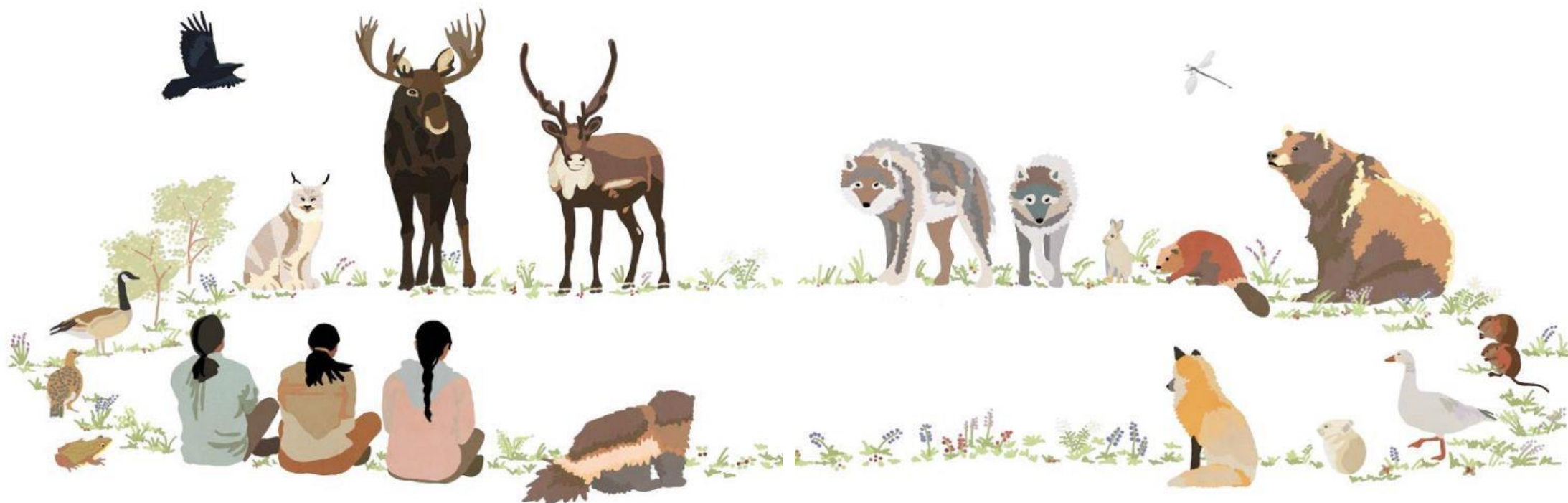
