

Policy Statement

➢ Viable conservation approaches that can be more effective, more rightscompliant and community-led alternatives to harvest limits.


Community-based, rights-compliance governance frameworks, reflecting and respecting local customs and practices.

Should be the priority response to wildlife conservation concerns in the Sahtú region.

Jurisdiction

- PLS is called as a hearing
- PLS helps SRRB make decisions about wildlife
- Ultimate authority in law lies with GNWT Minister


