3. Communications Strategy for Bluenose East ?ekwé Hearing

Presentation by Joanne Stassen

Discussion topics

- Joanne Stassen was hired on a short term independent contract to assist with Board communications related to the Bluenose East ?ekwé while on leave from CBC Radio North
- The communications strategy will be an opportunity to document current Board practices and what it intends to do
- To date, Joanne has identified key areas where we are facing challenges with communication, for example when dealing with the media
- Reporters may not understand full complexities of concepts and issues, and may focus on numbers to create a conflict that doesn't exist

Leonard Kenny joins call at 9:30 am

- A guide can be prepared on what to emphasize and what to be cautious about discussing
- Leonard Kenny has been receiving a lot of requests for interviews from the media, and had a frustrating experience with a journalist who misinterpreted one of his statements
- The value of Dene language media
- Provision of assistance to Board spokespeople to prepare for interviews
- Clarification that the Board can only talk about the hearing process, not the perspectives of the various parties about zekwé management

4. Colville Letter Regarding Bluenose West ?ekwé Issues, January 25, 2016

Presentation by Deborah Simmons

Discussion topics

- The Colville letter is a follow-up to the December 8-11 SRRB meeting with Colville, in Colville Lake
- Colville agrees to provide harvest data pending negotiation of a data sharing agreement; this will affect timing for delivery of the data
- Colville supports SRRB reconsideration of Total Allowable Harvest
- Colville wants to be directly resourced for their participation in SRRB processes
- Distinction between the Dél₁ne conservation plan and Colville plan, in that the former will be approved through a hearing process
- Colville is registered as a party to the BNE hearing, since they believe that a decision regarding harvest of BNE pekwé will affect their harvest of BNW

5. Bluenose East ?ekwé Allocation Meeting, January 20

Presentation by Michael Neyelle and Deborah Simmons

Discussion topics

- Michael attended this meeting as an observer only (Deborah joined by teleconference)
- The Aboriginal parties are considering whether to use a precise formula with fractions to calculate allocations for smaller user groups, or offer a flat 2% allocation with slight reductions for larger user groups
- Nunavut representatives were present; a hearing will be held by the Nunavut Land Use Planning Board that is relevant to BNE calving grounds, and the Nunavut Wildlife Management Board envisions that a hearing will be required on BNE management
