Discussion topics

- 4 key things for Board to keep in mind:
 - Land claim agreement provisions on conflict of interest take precedence over everything else (specific, constitutionally protected)
 - o Therefore actions taken in normal conduct of regular employment or functions in Dene organizations are explicitly not in conflict
 - o Modified test for policy boards
 - Can look at practical factors re board being able to continue functioning, and prejudice to the board's process including cost, if adjournment
- Note that there is no reference to the Déljne ?ehdzo Got'jne in the Colville submission
- The Government of the NWT submission concludes no conflict of interest or bias, and no grounds to adjourn the hearing
- SRRB options: accept and request that Board members in question step down from hearing decision (in which case there's a problem with quorum), deny, or provide alternative relief to accommodate concerns
- Benefit of a ruling that puts in writing the Board's efforts to prevent risk of conflict of interest or bias
- Risk that the Parties could request an injunction to stop the hearing
- Approach to presenting Board ruling in the media; Paul will be the spokesperson
