Report Update

Notice to Sahtú leaders, Parties, and neighbours, **October 26, 2020**

The SRRB has been working diligently to complete the Colville 2020 Public Listening report. The completed draft report has been reviewed by Board Members, and one more review has been requested before formal approval. Therefore, the timeline for publication of the report is now set at **October 30, 2020**.

Reminder of Publication Protocol

As noted in our April 28 update, Minister Shane Thompson responded to the Board's first notice regarding the changed report timeline with direction that the report be released to the public immediately upon completion. Thus the Minister has waived the right outlined section 13.8.24 of the *Sahtú Dene and Métis Comprehensive Land Claim Agreement* to a 60-day review period before the report is made public.
